Charter a federal emergency response working group to:

- Establish a cadre of highly skilled procurement professionals available to respond to national emergencies and disasters.
- Develop a collaborative resource to support the cadre and the acquisition community

Goal & Enabling Strategies

Goal:

Establish a cadre of highly skilled procurement professionals available to respond to national emergencies and disasters and, Develop a collaborative resource tool to support the cadre and the acquisition community.

Enabling Strategies:

- 1. Compile a list of volunteers that may be available for deployment.**
- 2. Identify, leverage, develop a specialized suite of emergency, response and recovery training courses.**
- 3. Provide a Federal wide collaborative resource tool to promote knowledge and resource sharing across the Government which includes:**
 - a. Repository of resources and job support assets to include policy and procedure information, training resources, interagency contracts, human resources information and e-tools and links.**
- 4. Embrace a culture of performance excellence and continuous partnership**
- 5. Senior leadership and sustainment support**

Two Phase Development Approach

Phase I

1. Identify Volunteers for possible emergency response

- Chief Acquisition Officers Council (CAOC) requested a call for volunteers (9 June 2006 suspense)
 - Currently have 60+ names
 - Polling internal DHS Components (Less FEMA)
 - Potential addition from last years volunteers



Phase I

2. Designate suite of training for volunteers

- **Basic Emergency Response Qualifications**
 - Contracting Certification Level I, II, or III
 - Modified DAU contingency contracting course
 - FEMA on-line training classes
 - » Introduction to the Incident Command System
 - » Basic Incident Command System for Disaster Workers
 - » National Incident Management System
 - » National Response Plan

- **Advanced Emergency Response Qualifications**
 - Basic Emergency Response Qualifications
 - FEMA on-line training classes
 - » Intermediate Incident Management System
 - » Advanced Incident Command System



Phase I

3. Develop, integrate and sustain a repository of learning and job support assets to foster knowledge sharing across the federal acquisition community to support emergency incidents

- May 2006 – developed prototype for CAOC and Working Group
- July 12, 2006 - estimated deployment date for Emergency Response and Recovery

Benefit and Value of the Emergency Response and Recovery Community of Practice

- Fosters knowledge sharing within the Federal Acquisition Community
- Broadens existing knowledge base
- Optimizes human capital resources
- Supports Disaster Relief and Recovery efforts



Two Phase Development Approach

Phase II (In Development)

1. Training (Federal Acquisition Institute (FAI) led development)

- Limited offerings 7 August and 21 August in DC metro area of modified contingency contracting course materials with limited offerings
- Develop specific Emergency Response and Recovery course (estimated deployment date – FY07 – second quarter)

2. Workforce Certification

- Institute supplementary acquisition workforce certification endorsement for emergency response contracting cadre

Interagency Contracting

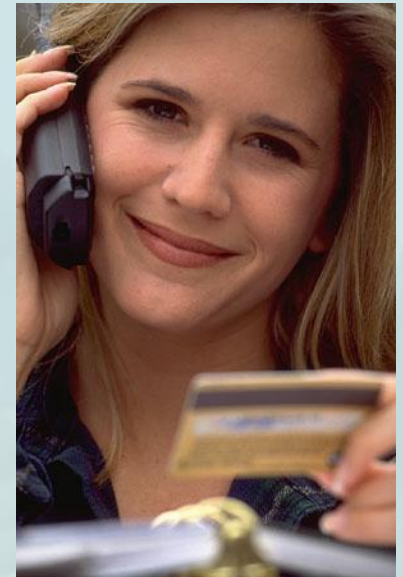
- **Interagency Contracting:**
